



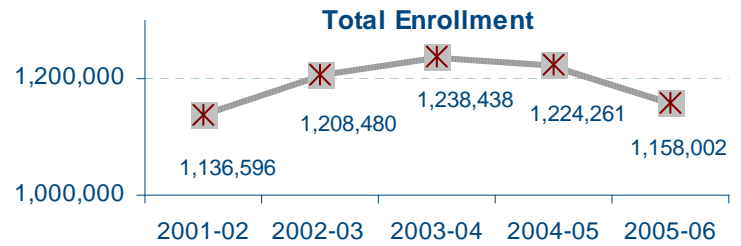

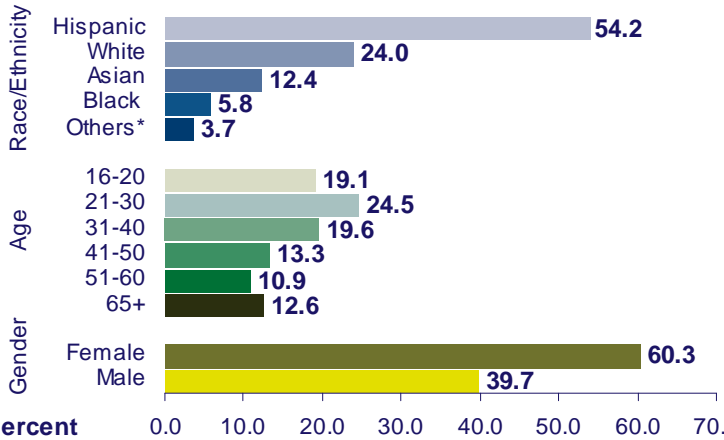

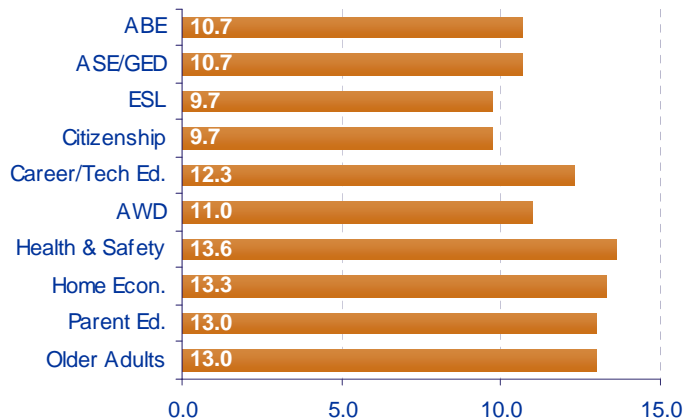

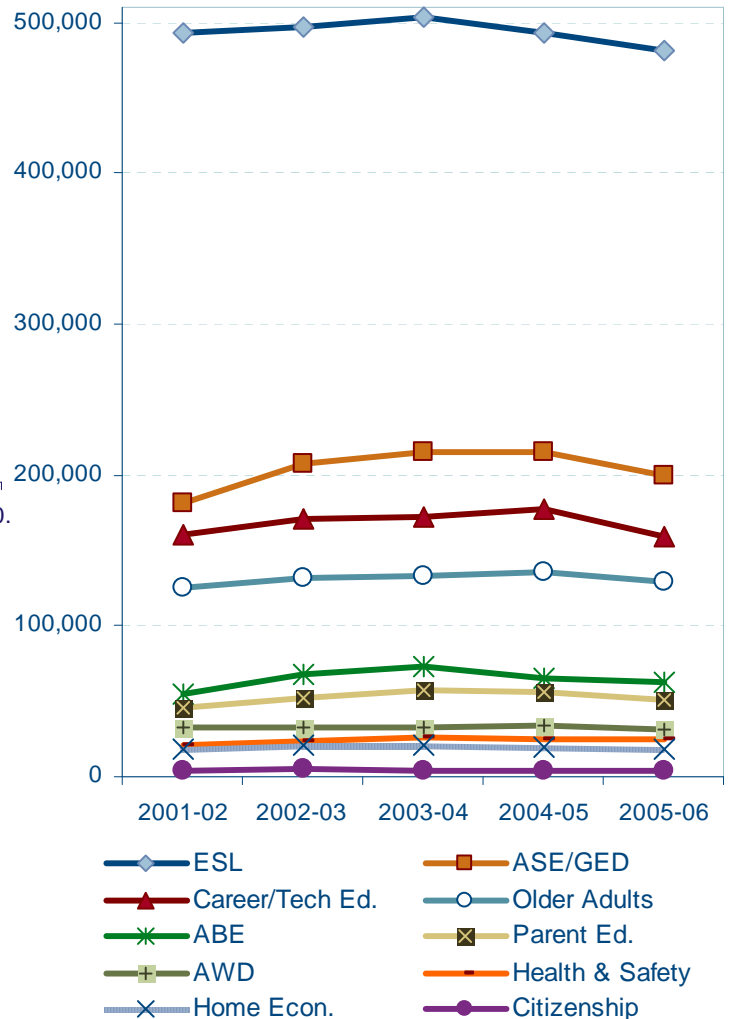

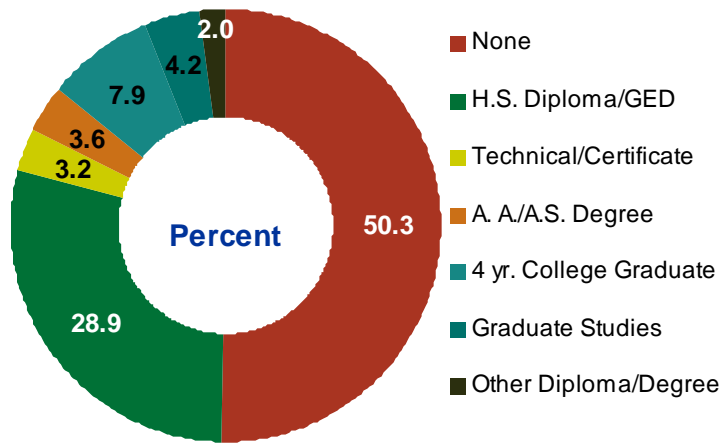
Average Years of Schooling



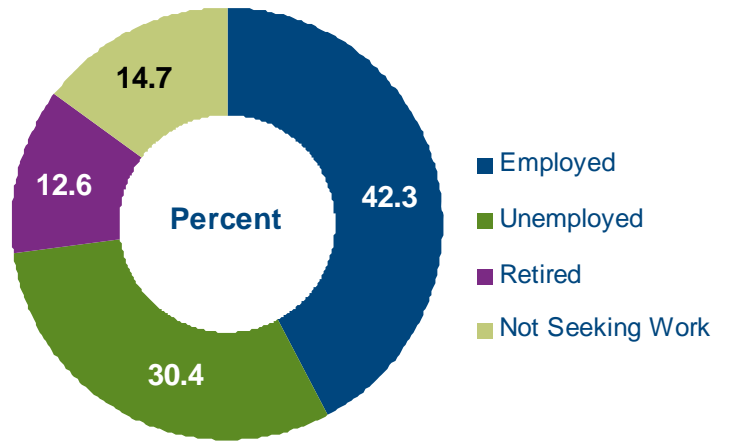
Enrollment by Program



Highest Diploma or Degree Earned

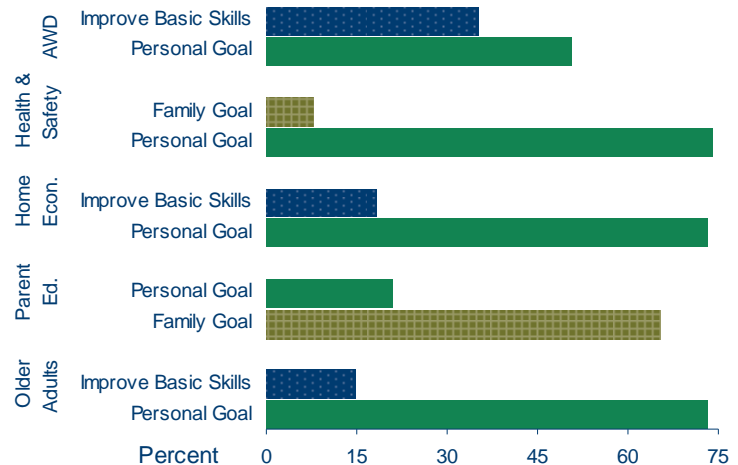
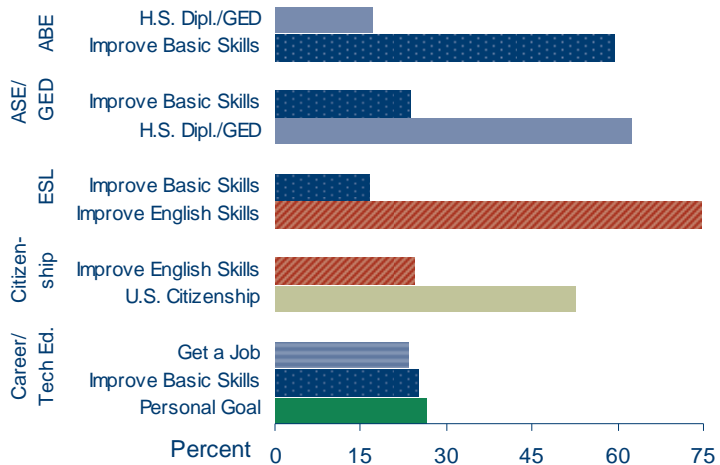


Labor Force Status
